

2017-18 CFCC Student Ambassador Application Packet

Completed applications and three recommendation forms due Thursday, March 9, 2017. All materials must be submitted online.

Ambassador Job Duties:

- Serve as a resource for current and prospective students
- Host on-campus visits and give campus tours
- Assist with CFCC Foundation events and functions
- Serve as orientation leaders at orientation sessions for new students and parents
- Facilitate and assist with registration and graduation
- Communicate with College donors via phone and through one-on-one contact
- Attend student ambassador training sessions and meetings
- Work with various campus departments as needed

Applicants must:

- Be enthusiastic, motivated, creative, friendly, and possess leadership qualities
- Possess good written, interpersonal, and group presentation skills and
- Enjoy representing the college and be able to effectively present the positive attributes of CFCC
- Be sensitive to the needs of current and potential students
- Be able to work well with others in a team environment
- Have enough scheduling flexibility and access to transportation **to attend and/or host three to five day or evening events on behalf of the Foundation office per academic semester**
- Understand that Ambassador service requirements / activities must be considered first priority in light of other work commitments
- Be a current **full-time CFCC student who will have successfully completed at 24 Credit Hours at CFCC prior to ambassadorship term which begins in August.** (Preference is given to applicants who have most recently been full-time students or who have been full-time the majority of their semesters at CFCC.)
- Plan to be enrolled as a **full-time student (12 hours minimum)** in good academic standing at CFCC for the upcoming fall ***and*** spring semesters
- **Meet and maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5.** If you do not currently meet the minimum GPA requirement but feel you would be able to perform the job at a high level, you may submit your application with a letter explaining how your academic situation has improved and how you can perform the duties of the position while maintaining a GPA above 2.5. Preference will be given to applicants who meet the minimum 2.5 GPA requirement.
- Complete application and submit with at least three recommendations or letters of support from faculty or staff members (minimum 2 from CFCC, 1 from external sources).
