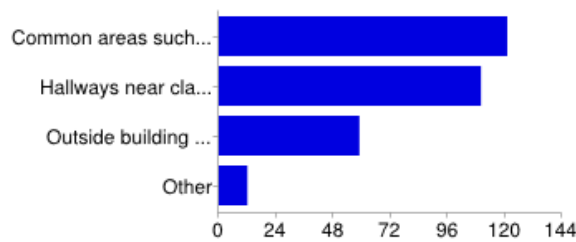

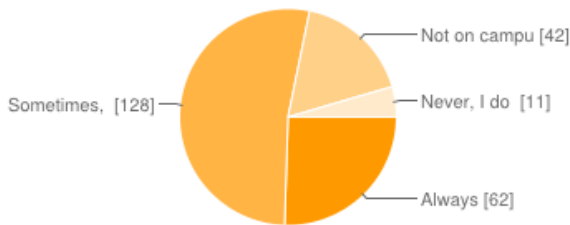
Summary

Where would campus recycling receptacles be most useful?



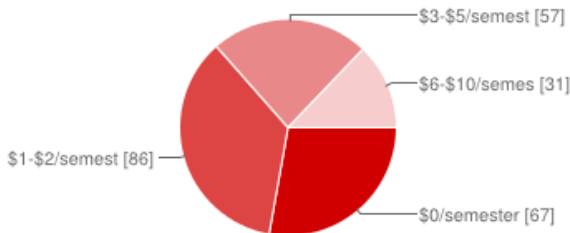
Common areas such as lobbies, lounges, and cafeterias	121	49.6%

Do you recycle paper, bottles, and cans on campus?



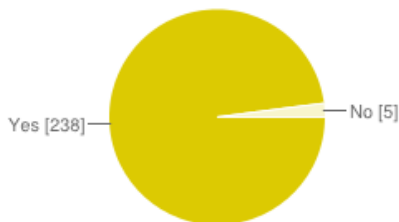
Always	62	25.4%
