

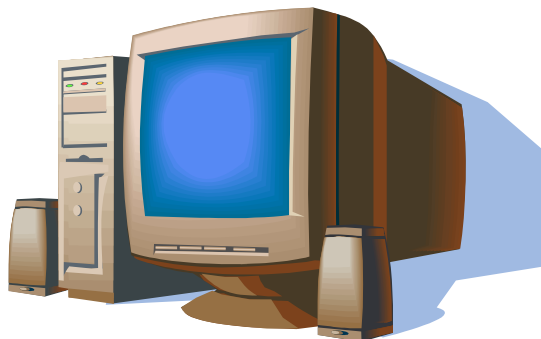


A+ Certification Prep

Program Description:

The “CompTIA A+ Certification” is the industry standard for computer support technicians. This international, vendor-neutral certification proves competence in areas such as computer installation, preventative maintenance, networking, security and troubleshooting.

This 96 hr. A+ Certification Prep course prepares students to test for the CompTIA A+ Certification, 2009 Edition. Students must pass two exams to be A+ certified: CompTIA A+ Essentials, exam code 220-701; and CompTIA A+ Practical Application, exam code 220-702.



Students will learn the hardware common to virtually every personal computer, including microprocessors, RAM, power supplies, motherboards, BIOS, CMOS, the expansion bus, and input/output devices. Students will also know how to install, configure, and maintain hard drives, removable drives, and printers, as well as master the Windows operating system. The course utilizes lecture/demonstration, online lessons, class discussion, and physical lab exercises.
