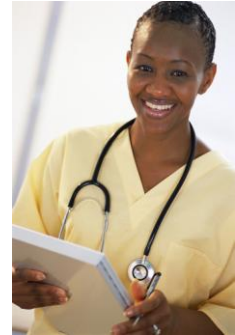

Program Description:

This course teaches direct patient care geared towards students who are entering the health care field at the basic level. This course prepares students for state competency testing.

Prerequisites: High School diploma, GED, or CASAS reading and math proficiency test. Copy of education diploma (or reading and math test scores), driver’s license and Social Security card required.



Textbooks required: Mosby’s Textbook for Nursing Assistants

Supplies or Other Requirements: Classroom: Stethoscope, Blood Pressure Cuff. Clinicals: Uniform, Current physical examination, Current TB test, Updated Vaccinations (Tetanus, Rubella, Rubeola, Varicella, Hepatitis B Vaccinations or signed waiver), Current Health Care Provider, American Heart Association CPR card, Criminal background check.
