

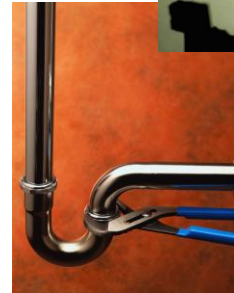


Plumbing Apprenticeship (Part I)

Program Description:

The course provides students with the necessary skills to successfully enter the professional Plumbing Contracting field. Coursework includes classroom knowledge with hands-on skill development.

Students will understand the importance of job safety, identify plumbing tools and their proper use, understand basic blueprint reading, recognize the different types of plumbing materials and their proper use, and be able to layout, install, and repair plumbing systems with limited supervision. Upon completion of this course, students should pass the New Hanover County Journeyman Exam and enter the Plumbing field with a highly-respected "Journeyman Certification".
