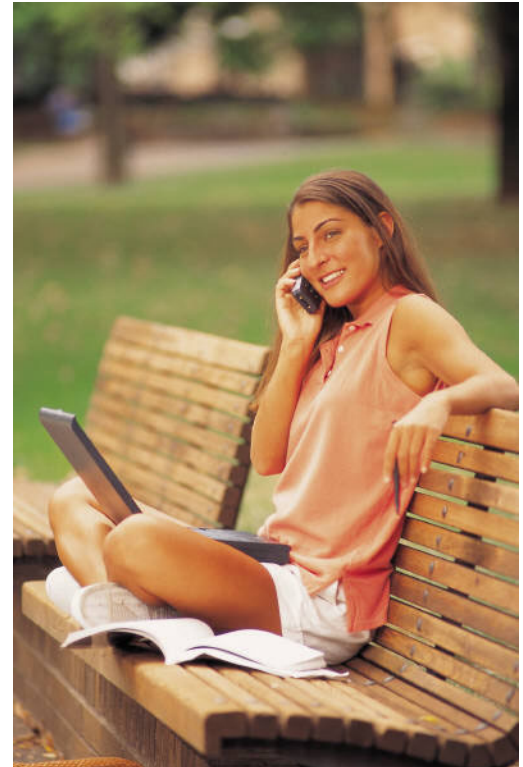
"What is Distance Learning?"

Distance Learning (DL) is a formal educational process in which the majority of the instruction occurs when student and instructor are not in the same place (COC/SACS, 2000).

There are two main types of DL courses:

Hybrid - meets 1-3 times per week on-site with remainder of course online.

Internet - meets online (some courses require face-to-face or proctored testing or presentations at approved sites).

How do I setup my login for Blackboard?

(Also applies to CampusCruiser & WebAdvisor)

On the login page for Bb, CC and WA you will see two links: "What's My Username?" & "What's my Password?"

For "What's My Username?" you will need your Student ID Number. This is on your class schedule, acceptance letter or ID card.

For "What's my Password?" be sure to use the first four digits of your Social Security number, as well as the Zip Code CFCC has on file.

If you are a prospective student you will have access to WebAdvisor only. You will receive access to CampusCruiser and Blackboard when you register for classes.

The Blackboard Tutorial is a preview of online courses. After you register for an online course, the tutorial will be on your course list, in Blackboard. Check out the video tutorials prior to the first class day.

The Learning Lab (LL) offers course specific tutoring as well as help with tools used in Blackboard such as using the Discussion Board and submitting attachments.
