

To access **JSTOR** go to www.cfcc.edu/lrc, under **Research Tools** click on **Articles & eResources**, then choose **JSTOR**.

If you are off campus you will be prompted for your **CFCC Username/Password**.

To begin your search, type topic in the search box(s). Be sure to un-check the “Include links to external content” box.

You can sort the articles results by **Relevance** or by **Date**. To view, click on the **Article Title**.

For a direct link to the article, click on **PDF** or **copy Article (Stable) URL**.
