To access **Literature Resource Center** go to www.cfcc.edu/lrc, under **Research Tools** click on **Articles & eResources**, then choose **Literature Resource Center**.

If you are off campus you will be prompted for your **CFCC Username/Password**.

To begin your Search, type your topic into the search box. Be sure to check the "documents with full text" box to give you immediate access to articles. Option: If you need Peer-Reviewed publications, check that box too.

Option 1: Click on Bookmark this Document. This will provide you the article's URL that you can post to your online course. Don't just give students a URL! It helps them (and the librarians) if you also include the article title.
