These are actual operations performed at medical centers in the United States since 2004. **The videos last an hour.** Please note that you cannot send in questions by email, though the webcast may say that you can, because you are not seeing these videos live.

The videos open in a second window. If you have a pop-up blocker, you will need to disable it to view the programs.

Internet Resources:

Anatomy Atlas (Winking Skull) – Offers the 2008 Atlas of Anatomy. The site includes 246 full-color illustrations from the Atlas, arranged by anatomic region, then by tissue layer (musculature, neurovasculature, bones, etc.). Users can magnify images and turn labels on and off. The site provides study and testing (mapping labels to the image) options for identification of anatomical features (this requires installation of a free plug-in, Microsoft Silverlight). Using WinkingSkull's study/testing features requires free individual registration.
