### About the Festival

This year marks the 11th annual Cape Fear Community College Boat Show on July 24, 2010. Presented by the CFCC Boat Building program, the show serves as an annual celebration of the craft of boat building. Held on the banks of the Cape Fear River in downtown Wilmington, CFCC's boat show attracts thousands of visitors every year.

This year, the event will feature a wide variety of wooden boats, including kayaks, skiffs, and boats from the Simmons Sea Skiff Club.



**New this year!** Fiberglass boats from professional boat dealers and boat building material suppliers from around the region are invited to join the show.

Students in CFCC's two boat building programs will exhibit their own work in wooden and fiberglass boat building. CFCC's boat building shops will be open for self-guided tours.

# Boat/Vendor Exhibitors:

**Location:** CFCC Wilmington Campus on the riverfront on Water St. (between the Hilton and Coastline Convention Center)

**Hours:** All boats and vendors must be ready to display between 9:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. on Saturday, July 24th.

**Judging and Awards:** All non-commercially made boats may be considered for judging. Awards will be presented at the dinner on Saturday evening.

**Entry Fees/Sponsorship options:** There is a \$50 charge for amateur boats and \$100 for each commercial vessel and/or vendor booth. Sponsorships are also available for businesses who wish to show more than one boat and be featured in promotional materials. All entrants are entitled to a free t-shirt and are invited to attend a dinner on Saturday night. Please indicate the number of guests for the dinner on the application form. **All checks should be made payable to CFCC Foundation, Inc.**

If you have ever wanted to build a boat, now is your chance! Up to six teams will be selected to participate in the **2010 CFCC Build-A-Boat** on July 24, 2010. Each team will build a 7' 6" wooden row boat from a pre-cut marine-plywood kit with materials and plans under the guidance of a student mentor. *Boats do not include paint, oars, or oarlocks.*

**All teams will get to keep the boats they build.**



The event will take all day, but seeing your completed work for first time is a great pay-off!

The cost of participating is **\$450** per team.

**All proceeds benefit boat building scholarships at CFCC.**

Teams will be entered on a first-come, first served basis.

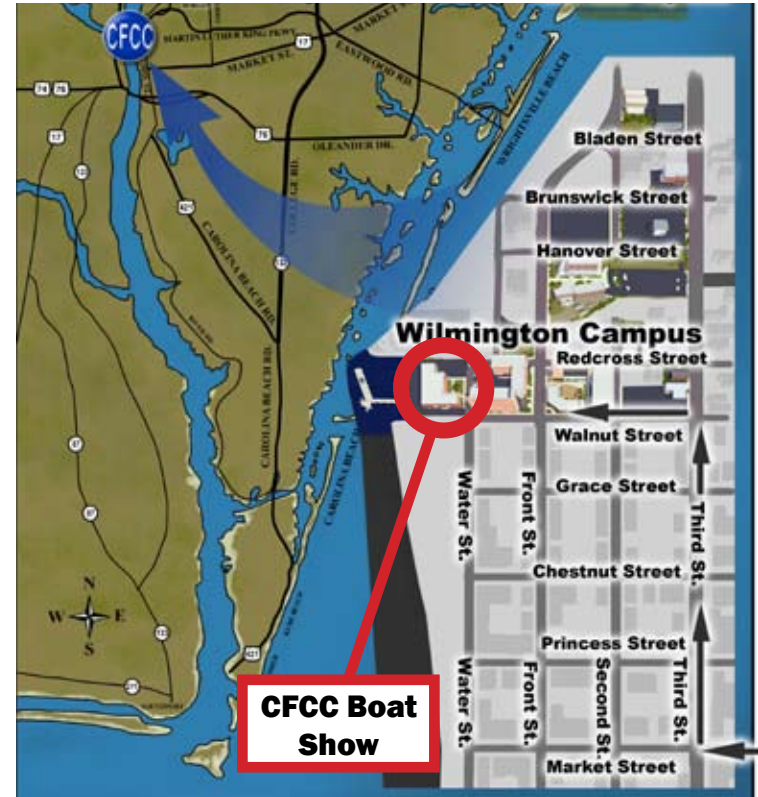

## Driving Directions to CFCC



**From the North (I-40):** Follow I-40 to Wilmington and take a right on Martin Luther King Parkway. Follow parkway about 7 miles and take downtown Wilmington exit to Third St. Turn right on Walnut St. Drive to Water St. and turn right. Parking is on the right.

**From the West (Brunswick County):** Take Rt. 74/76 over the Cape Fear Memorial Bridge. After the bridge, turn left on to Third St. Drive approx. 1.5 miles until you get to Walnut St. Turn left on Walnut St. and drive to Water St. turn right. Parking is on the right.

**From the South (Brunswick County and S.C.):** Take Rt. 74/76 over the Cape Fear Memorial Bridge. After the bridge, turn left on to Third St. Drive approx. 1.5 miles until you get to Walnut St. Turn left on Walnut St. and drive to Water St. turn right. Parking is on the right.
