Quality Time with Developmental Education

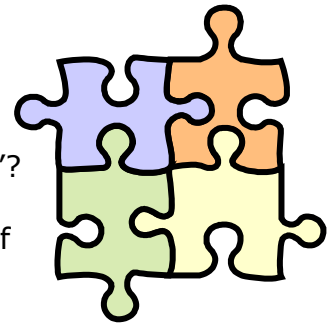
