The program recognized demonstrates excellence through anecdotal records and letters from students, faculty, and administrators as well as by statistical outcome measures. Documentation should follow the guidelines for the NADE John Champaign award.

C. Outstanding Alumnus of a Program

This award recognizes a former student of a program associated with NCADE who is a source of pride for the program. Documentation should follow guidelines for the NADE Outstanding Alumnus of a Developmental Education Program.
