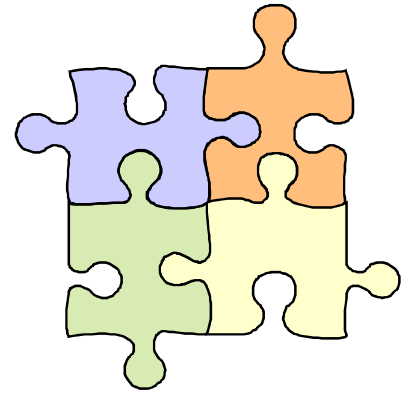

3. Attach an abstract (30 - 50 words) of your presentation. This abstract will appear in the conference program once the proposal is accepted.
4. Email your proposal package to the contact for the specific regional conference at which you wish to present.
