Courses like the following do not require separate labs: BIO 168, MAT 271, MAT 272, and MAT 273. Some students may be able to complete the Diploma with the minimum 44 credit hours. Students may select an optional or non-required hour (1 SHC) from any unused general education core courses and/or from the electives listed on the back of this sheet. UNC institutions may evaluate each additional course on a course-by-course basis. Students should always check with the senior institution for the latest transfer information.
