

Information for New Evening Block Schedule

Program Name: CFCC's After Hours Program

Concept: This fall, CFCC will begin offering a new way for working students to earn their Associate in Arts degree. Students in the After Hours Program will take classes Tuesday and Thursday evenings and will be on track to complete their degree in just two years. This program consists of some of the most popular and commonly accepted college transfer classes. Students completing the After Hours Program will be well-positioned for transfer to one of the state's four-year institutions.

This will be a limited-enrollment program. Prospective students will meet with a CFCC advisor to determine whether the After Hours Program is right for them. To be eligible for the program, students must meet all registration requirements for ENG-111 (Writing and Inquiry) and MAT-171 (Precalculus Algebra) in their first semester.

Benefits to Students: Students enrolling in the After Hours Program will benefit from a consistent schedule of evening classes leading to the completion of CFCC's Associate in Arts degree in two years' time. Students will also benefit from small class sizes, membership in a cohort of like-minded peers, and focused support services.

Program Logistics: All the classes in the After Hours Program will be scheduled for Tuesday and Thursday evenings on the college's Wilmington Campus. Classes will typically begin at 5:30 PM each evening and run until just after 9 PM. The program includes one summer session which will also consist of Tuesday and Thursday evening classes. Students in the After Hours Program will take four to five classes each term (two classes for the summer term). All the classes offered through the program will include both seated and online components.

Students who are interested in the After Hours Program should complete CFCC's application process, including residency determination and financial aid. Once students have completed the application process and are accepted to CFCC, they will meet with an After Hours Program advisor to discuss whether the program is a good fit with their academic goals and current obligations. Students who determine that the program is right for them and who are ENG-111 and MAT-171 ready will be registered for the fall block of After Hours Program classes (G sections) by a program advisor.

Enrollment in the After Hours Program will be limited to 24 students for the fall 2017 cohort. After Hours Program students will be asked to attend a special new student orientation before the start of the fall term. These students will also meet with a program advisor mid-semester for registration for spring 2018 semester After Hours Program classes.
