PREPARE TO APPLY

- ☐ Plan your path - Research 4 year institutions
- ☐ See how your courses may transfer
- ☐ Continue earning transferable credits
- ☐ Review transfer application deadlines

HOW TO APPLY

- ☐ Apply Online. Check your college's admissions or transfer page for what options they accept.
- ☐ Pay the Application Fee. Application Fee Waivers may be available for each school.
- ☐ Select a Major.
- ☐ Complete Required documents - Include essays, letters of recommendations, and additional test scores where applicable (i.e.: SAT, ACT, AP, IB, CLEP, etc.).
- ☐ Submit Your Transcripts:
 - ☐ Official transcript(s) from all colleges and/or universities attended
 - ☐ An official high school transcript showing your date of graduation or proof of a GED or Adult High School Diploma
 - ☐ Home-Schooled students must submit a notarized transcript signed by the School Administrator

TYPES OF DECISIONS YOU MAY RECEIVE FROM THE UNIVERSITY

- **Admit:** Some students will get admitted right away.
- **Pending Current Grades:** Applicants for admission may be requested to submit their current grades to help 4 year institutions make a final decision.
- **Waitlist:** Some institutions may place applicants on the waitlist who believe they would be successful if space becomes available.
- **Deny:** Unfortunately, some students will not be considered competitive for transfer admission at this time. We encourage denied applicants to review our recommendations for competitive applicants.
