- Completion of BIO 168 and PSY 150 (or be currently enrolled in; must pass both courses) with a grade of "C" or better
- An unrestricted North Carolina Practical Nursing license on file with HSEC
- Completion of TEAS exam (minimum score of 59 in all four areas). Should submit highest scoring test with intent if testing multiple times.
- Documentation of work experience on file at CFCC (criteria waived for LPNs who have graduated within the last twelve (12) months)
