- A current second year Sonography student in good standing, enrolled in a CAAHEP accredited Sonography program, OR a recent sonography graduate from a CAAHEP accredited program (within the last 3 years), OR a current practicing registered sonographer
- Completion of BIO 168 with a grade of "C" or better within the last five years
- Completion of a college level Physics class with a grade of "C" or better
- Completion of a college level Medical Terminology class (3) semester hours) within the last five years with a grade of "C" or
- · Completion of COM 110, 120, OR 231 (or transfer equivalent) with a grade of "C" or better
- Completion of TEAS exam (minimum of 59 as total score). Should submit highest scoring test with intent if testing multiple times
