- Completion of MAT 152 OR 171 OR higher with a grade of "C" or better
- Completion of a college level Physics class with a grade of "C" or better
- Completion of a college level Medical Terminology class (3 semester hours) within the last five years with a grade of "C" or better
- Completion of COM 110, 120, **OR** 231 (or transfer equivalent) with a grade of "C" or better
- · Completion of TEAS exam (minimum of 59 as total score). Should submit highest scoring test with intent if testing multiple times
