## MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS (must be completed in order to apply to the program)

- Interested applicants must study information packet (see website)
- Admission to CFCC (by Admissions) or active application status
- · Official high school transcript on file at CFCC
- · Official college/university transcripts (if applicable) on file at CFCC
- · English and Math eligibility
- · Overall GPA at CFCC of 2.5 or higher (criteria waived if students do not have an established GPA at CFCC)
- Attendance of one mandatory information session (documentation must be on file with the HSEC. Must complete survey)
- Completion of a high school or college level biology course with a grade of "C" or higher within five years of the start date of the VMT Program
- 10 hrs veterinary observation verification form
- Completion of TEAS exam (minimum 59% in all four areas). Should submit highest scoring test with intent if testing multiple times
